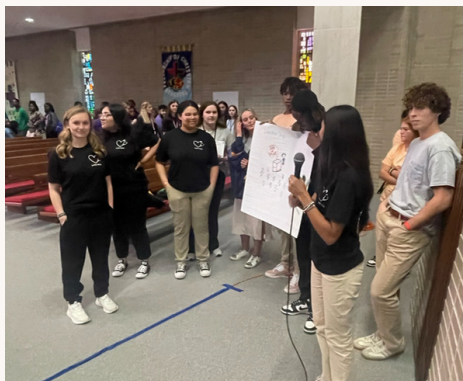

Consistently hold meetings to inform your remembers of upcoming events with SC HOSA or your chapter. Use meetings to build a community around members while also keeping it informational.



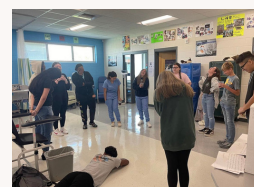
SERVICE EVENTS

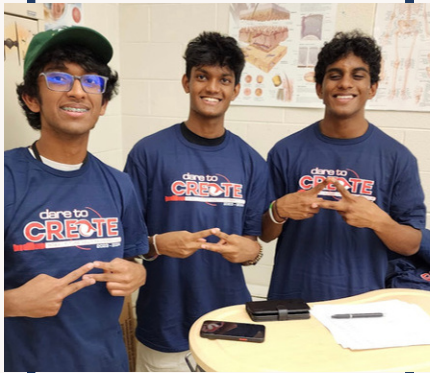

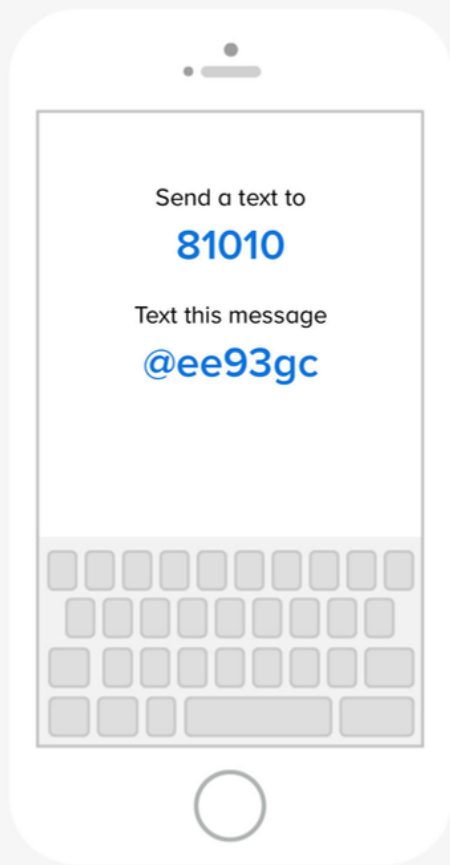
