Consider becoming a SC HOSA state officer. As a state officer you will represent SC HOSA and meet new people from across our state and other officers from around the nation.

Here are the simple steps:

- (1) Consult with your advisor to obtain support to seek office.
- (2) Download the officer package at www.schosa.org/forms.
- (3) **Mail** your forms on time. (Deadline is February 17, 2012.)
- (4) Meet with the nominating committee at the SC Department of Education, Thursday, March 1 at your scheduled appointment time for the interview and officer candidate test.
- (5) If slated, meet with your chapter and advisor to plan your campaign. Be creative, but follow the guidelines. Whether it be a catchy slogan like "Don't Be A Rotten Egg, Vote For Greg" or just passing out candy to fellow HOSA members and telling them your ideas for the upcoming membership year. Begin campaigning as soon as you arrive.
- (6) Prepare your introduction for Thursday night on-stage session at the conference.
- (7) Remember, you are already a winner if you are an active HOSA member!
