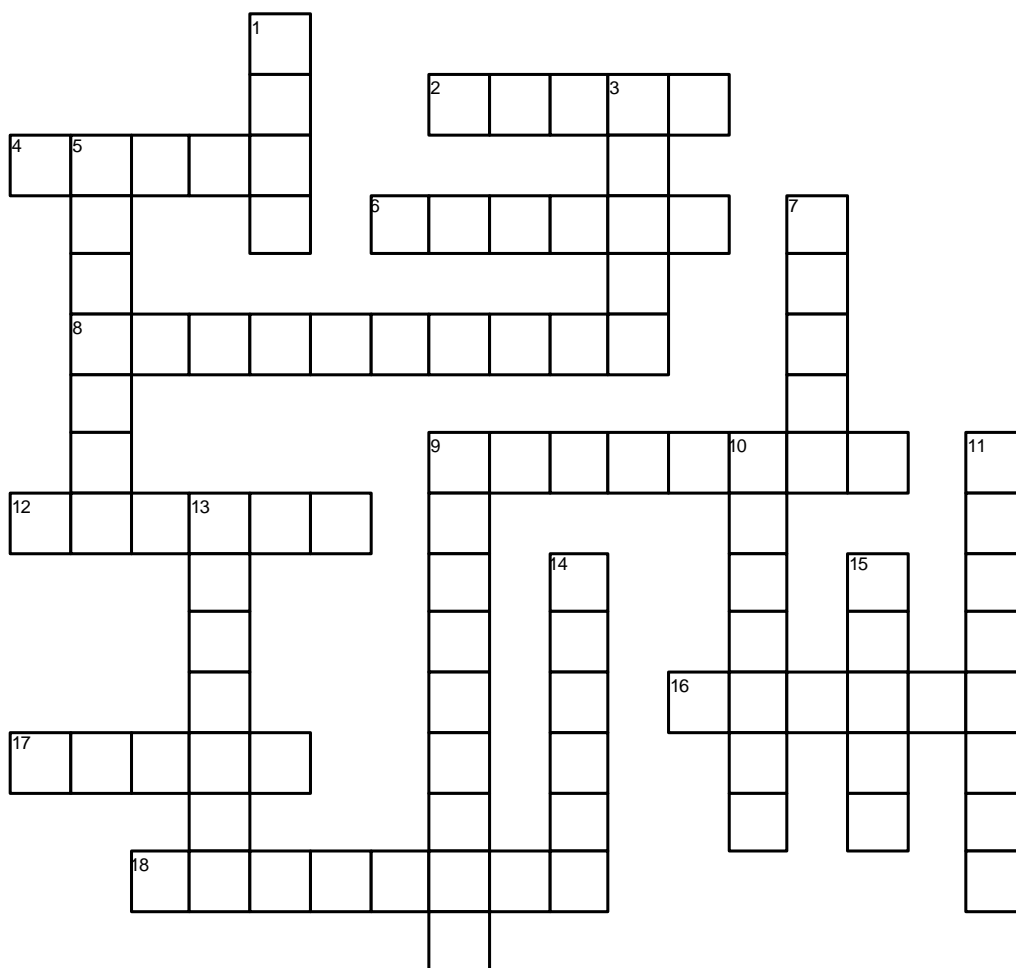


# Fun with Anatomy



## ACROSS

- 16 This muscular organ contains "taste buds".
