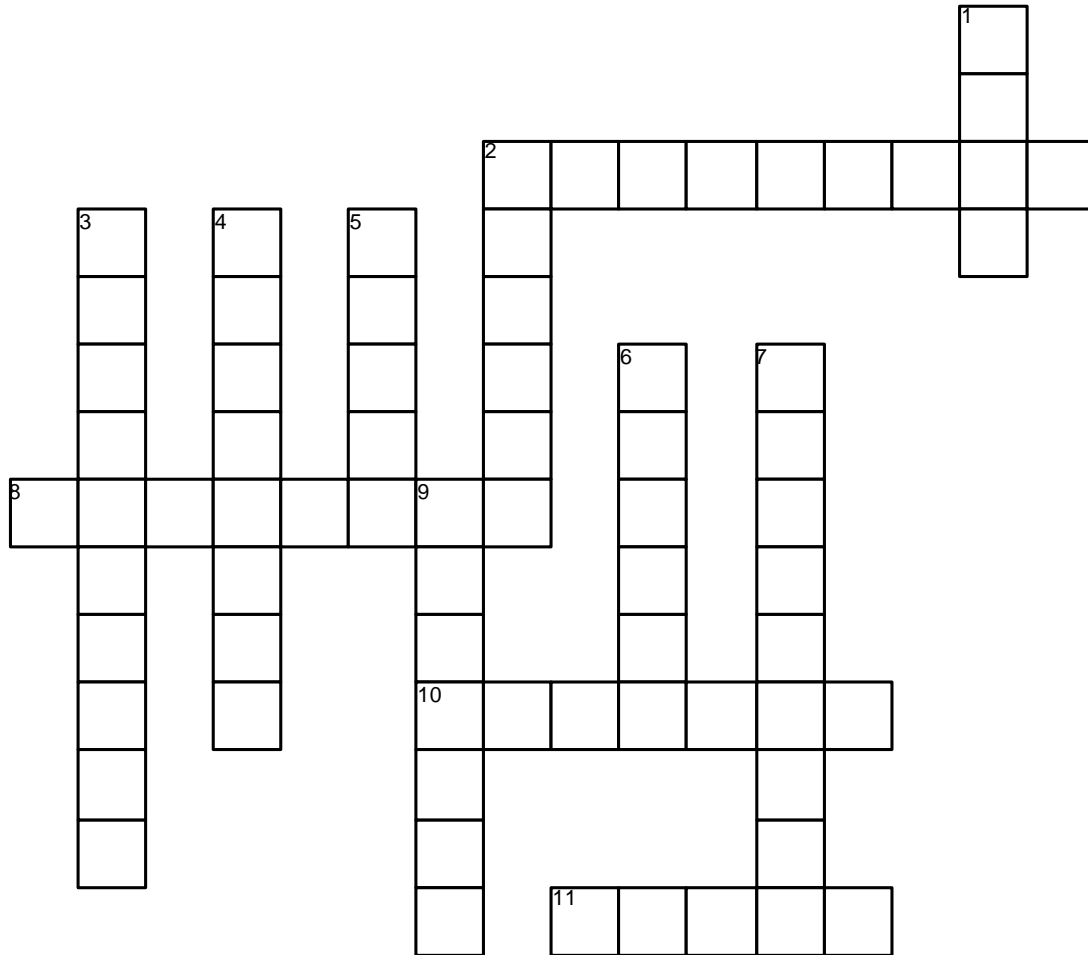


Medical Trivia
