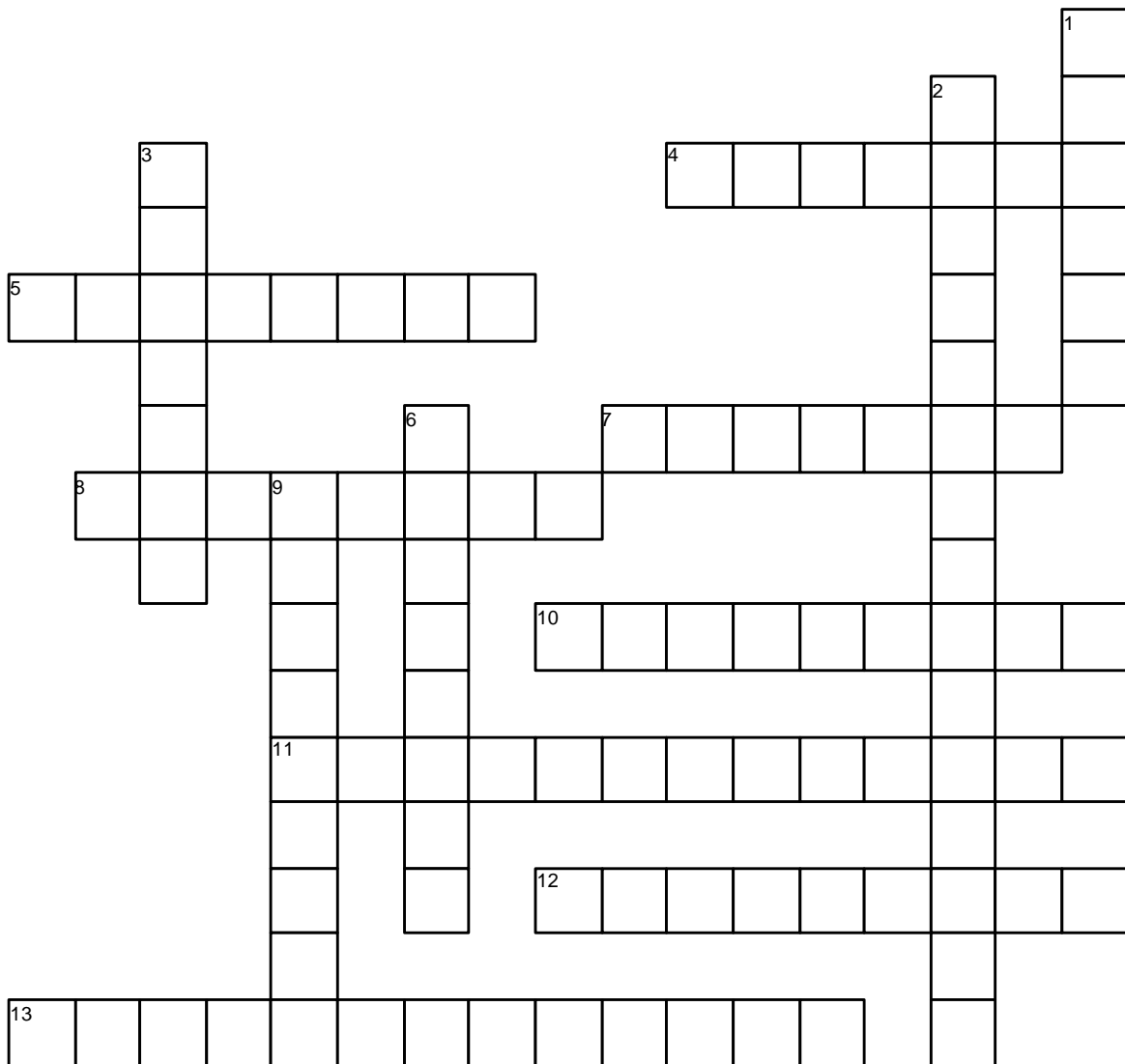


Muscular System



ACROSS

- 4 the are strong, tough connective tissue cords that attach muscles to bones
- 5 this type of muscle is attached to bones and causes body movement
- 7 this type of muscle forms the walls of the heart and contracts to circulate blood
- 8 turnig a body part around on its axis
- 10 increasing the angle between two bones, or straightening a body part
- 11 moving in a circle at a joint
- 12 moving a body part toward the midline
- 13 the ability to be stretched

DOWN

- 1 a tough sheet-like membrane that covers and protects the tissue
- 2 muscle fibers that are stimulated by nerves contract, or become short and thick, which causes movement
- 3 decreasing the angles between two bones, or bending a body part
- 6 this type of muscle is also called smooth muscle, and is found in the internal organs of the digestive and respiratory systems.
- 9 moving a body part away from the midline
