Application for free registration

I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this grant application is to enable high school teachers to apply for an award to receive a \$175 registration fee for the NCHSE Virtual Professional Development Conference. The scholarship funds must be used to attend the 2020 Virtual NCHSE Conference – October 27-31, 2020. Funds will be paid directly to NCHSE.

Teachers receiving the grant award must fulfill a curriculum requirement which incorporates the teaching of health science education. Scholarship recipients will be *required to submit electronically two virtual activities or projects* by **October 15, 2020** to Angel Clark, aclark@ed.sc.gov. The submitted materials may be posted on our SC Health Science Resources Google Drive. Failure to submit your activities will make you ineligible to receive any Health Science or HOSA scholarships for a period of no less than two years.

II. SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

Up to 25 high school teachers will be awarded free registration for this event with a value of \$175.00 each to support attendance to the 2020 NCHSE Virtual Professional Development Conference. Permissible use of funding includes conference registration only.

III. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Any high school teacher who currently teaches health science course(s) in a South Carolina high school or career and technology center is eligible to apply for the grant award.

IV. GUIDELINES

The completed application must be double spaced, with 12-point font (Arial or Times Roman) and not to exceed two pages.

CURRENT SITUATION & STATEMENT OF NEED (5 paragraphs worth 20 pts. Each)

1. Provide an introductory paragraph describing your health science education program
Include the following:
 - Your background and how you entered the teaching profession
 - Please note any medical licenses or certifications that you hold
 - Why you love teaching
2. Your second paragraph should include your goals and objectives for your individual professional development plan
3. Your third paragraph should include professional memberships and please state if you are a member of SC ACTE – HSE division. Why or why not?
4. Your third paragraph should discuss your involvement with SC HOSA
5. Provide a fourth paragraph on how conference attendance will benefit your students

VI. APPLICATION DUE DATE

Completed scholarship applications for the 2020 NCHSE Virtual Professional Development Conference are due **September 9, 2020**. Grant recipients will be notified by September 14, 2020. All conference information and registration are posted at:
