## ADVISOR INFORMATION

- 1. TESTING:** TESTING TAKES PLACE THIS WEEK. WE ADDED AN EXTRA DAY THAT TESTING WILL BE AVAILABLE. TESTING IS WEDNESDAY THROUGH SATURDAY FROM 8:00 AM UNTIL 8:00 PM AND DOES NOT REQUIRE A PROCTOR. WE CANNOT CHANGE ANYTHING TO FIT AN INDIVIDUAL'S SCHEDULE. MAKE SURE TO REMIND YOUR STUDENTS TO TEST, AS WE WILL NOT HAVE THE TEST AVAILABLE AT THE CONFERENCE. **EXTEMPORANEOUS WRITING IS ALSO TAKING PLACE ONLINE DURING THIS TIME FRAME.** THOSE TESTING AS A ROUND ONE, WILL FIND OUT WHO MOVES TO ROUND TWO WEDNESDAY NIGHT DURING OR AFTER OPENING SESSION. THOSE THAT ARE TESTING AS A "TEST ONLY" EVENT WILL NOT FIND OUT THEIR PLACEMENT UNTIL FRIDAY AT THE AWARDS SESSION. ALL TESTING INFORMATION HAS BEEN SENT OUT TO BOTH ADVISORS AND STUDENTS. PLEASE CHECK YOUR JUNK MAIL AND HAVE YOUR STUDENTS CHECK THEIR JUNK MAIL FOR THEIR LOG ON CREDENTIALS. SOME SCHOOLS BLOCK THE EMAILS TO STUDENTS IF THEY LISTED THEIR SCHOOL ADDRESS. WE WILL REFER THE STUDENTS TO THEIR ADVISOR FOR THEIR LOG ON INFORMATION. YOU MAY WANT TO GO AHEAD AND GIVE THE LOG ON INFORMATION TO EACH INDIVIDUAL STUDENT. PLEASE DO NOT GET THE CREDENTIALS MIXED UP AS IT WILL NOT ALLOW THE STUDENT TO SIGN IN TO THE RIGHT TEST.
- 2. FORMS:** THIS IS A REMINDER TO MAKE SURE THAT YOU HAVE A COPY OF YOUR STUDENTS SIGNED CODE OF CONDUCT AND MEDICAL FORMS IN SEPARATE MANILLA ENVELOPES TO TURN IN AT REGISTRATION. PLEASE LABEL THE ENVELOPES WITH YOUR SCHOOL NAME AND CONTENTS.
- 3. SILENT AUCTION:** ONCE AGAIN, WE WILL HAVE A RAFFLE/SILENT AUCTION TO RAISE FUNDS FOR STUDENT SCHOLARSHIPS OR "BE THE MATCH". WE WILL LET THE STUDENTS VOTE. THE RAFFLE WILL BE AVAILABLE ALL DAY ON THURSDAY, MARCH 17<sup>TH</sup>. THE DRAWING WILL TAKE PLACE BETWEEN THE RECOGNITION SESSION AND THE GRAND AWARDS SESSION AT 12:00 NOON ON FRIDAY, MARCH 18<sup>TH</sup>. IF YOU HAVE ITEMS YOU CAN DONATE TO THE FUNDRAISING, PLEASE BRING THEM TO US AT REGISTRATION ON WEDNESDAY OR STRAIGHT TO THE RAFFLE TABLES EARLY THURSDAY MORNING.
- 4. ADVISOR MEETING:** THERE WILL BE A BRIEF ADVISOR MEETING IMMEDIATELY AFTER OPENING SESSION IN BALLROOM A. **EVENT MANAGERS/ASSISTANTS WILL MEET IN BALLROOM A IMMEDIATELY AFTER THE ADVISOR MEETING. TRUTH BE TOLD, THIS SHOULD INCLUDE ALL OF YOU.**
- 5. STUDENT ID's:** STUDENTS MUST HAVE A PICTURE ID TO CHECK IN FOR THEIR EVENT. SCHOOL ID'S WILL BE ACCEPTED.

6. **LIGHT UPS:** STUDENTS/SCHOOLS ARE ENCOURAGED TO WEAR LIGHT UPS FOR OPENING SESSION. WE CELEBRATE WHERE WE CAN! WE DO HAVE SOME LIGHT UPS THAT WILL BE FOR SALE AT THE REGISTRATION INFORMATION TABLE – LIKE NECKLACES AND HEAD BANDS – BUT NOT MANY. EACH STUDENT WILL GET TWO LIGHT UP BRACELETS WITH THEIR REGISTRATION.
7. **EVENT ITEMS TO PICKUP:** FOR EVENTS WHERE STUDENTS HAVE TO LEAVE NOTEBOOKS OR ITEMS FOR JUDGES TO LOOK AT BEFORE, DURING OR AFTER THE EVENT, MAKE SURE TO HAVE STUDENTS PICK THOSE UP AT THE INFORMATION DESK ON THURSDAY SEVERAL HOURS AFTER THEIR EVENT. BY 8:00 PM AT THE LATEST. IF NOT PICKED UP, WE THROW THEM AWAY.
8. **AMAZON GIFT CARDS:** STUDENTS WILL HAVE OPPORTUNITIES TO WIN AMAZON GIFT CARDS FOR VISITING VENDORS AND ATTENDING SYMPOSIA. MORE DETAILS WILL BE EXPLAINED AT REGISTRATION AND THE ADVISOR MEETING.
9. **MASKS REQUIRED AT HOSA ACTIVITIES:** SINCE THERE WILL BE A TON OF PEOPLE IN ONE SPACE, WE ARE STILL REQUIRING MASKS AT HOSA ACTIVITIES. ESPECIALLY OPENING AND CLOSING SESSIONS. AT OTHER TIMES SHOULD STUDENTS OR ADVISORS BE IN A HIGH TRAFFIC OR POPULATED AREA WE ENCOURAGE MASKING AND, AT THE LEAST, SOCIAL DISTANCING. WHEN NOT ABLE TO SOCIAL DISTANCE WE DEFINITELY RECOMMEND MASKING JUST BECAUSE OF THE SHEER VOLUME OF BODIES IN ONE PLACE. STUDENTS AND ADVISORS WILL RECEIVE ONE HOSA CLOTH MASK AND A HAND SANITIZER AS PART OF THEIR REGISTRATION.
10. **ADVISOR LUNCHEON:** AS IN THE PAST WE WILL BE HOSTING AN ADVISOR LUNCHEON FROM 11:30 AM – 1:30 PM IN THE EMBASSY RESTAURANT AREA ON THURSDAY, MARCH 17<sup>TH</sup>. FOR ADVISORS THAT ARE WORKING EVENTS OR JUDGING EVENTS DURING THESE HOURS WE WILL BRING LUNCH TO YOU. WE WILL ANNOUNCE AT THE ADVISOR MEETING WHO WILL HAVE LUNCHES DELIVERED TO THEM.
11. **DRESS CODE:** PLEASE MAKE SURE STUDENTS FOLLOW THE DRESS CODE. STUDENTS NOT DRESSED PROPERLY MAY BE DENIED ENTRY INTO ANY OF THE SESSIONS.
