#### **Early HOSA History**

In the early 1970s....

- Idea was first conceived by six charter states at an organizing meeting in Cherry Hill, New Jersey in November of 1975
- HOSA was officially organized at a Constitutional Convention held in Arlington, Texas in 1976
- Comprised only six states with nearly 6000 student members



#### **Early HOSA History**

- Lynee McGee First President
- HOSA Colors Maroon, Navy, and Medical White
- "The Hands of HOSA Mold the Health of Tomorrow"
- HOSA recognized by the U.S. Department of Education
- South Carolina created the HOSA Creed in 1980
- In 2004, the name officially changed to "HOSA - Future Health Professionals"

  - And, in widely diversified health care delivery fields...


