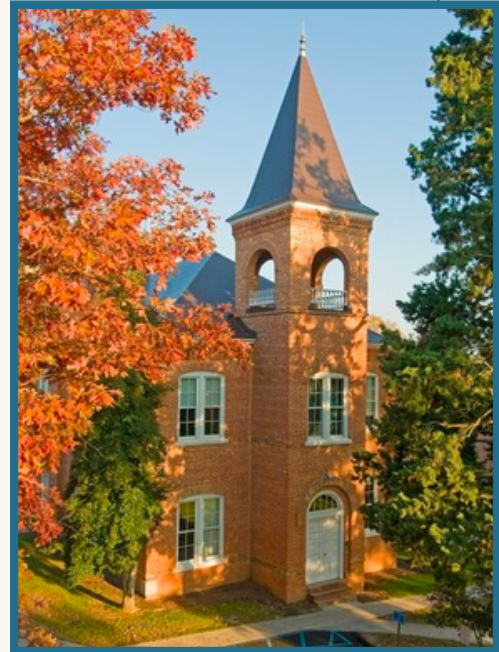

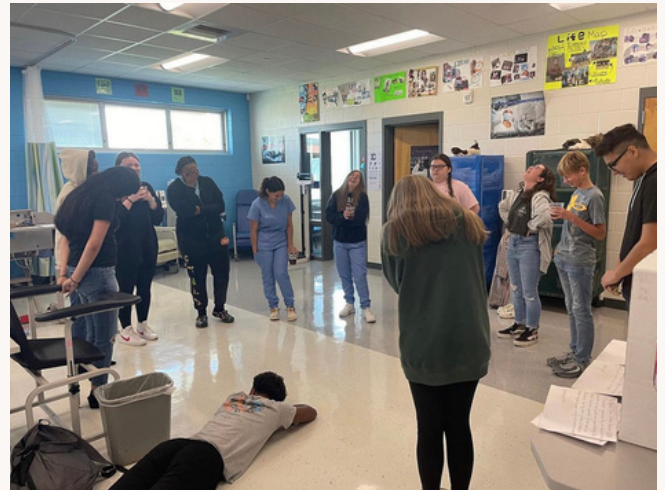
LEXINGTON TECH CENTER

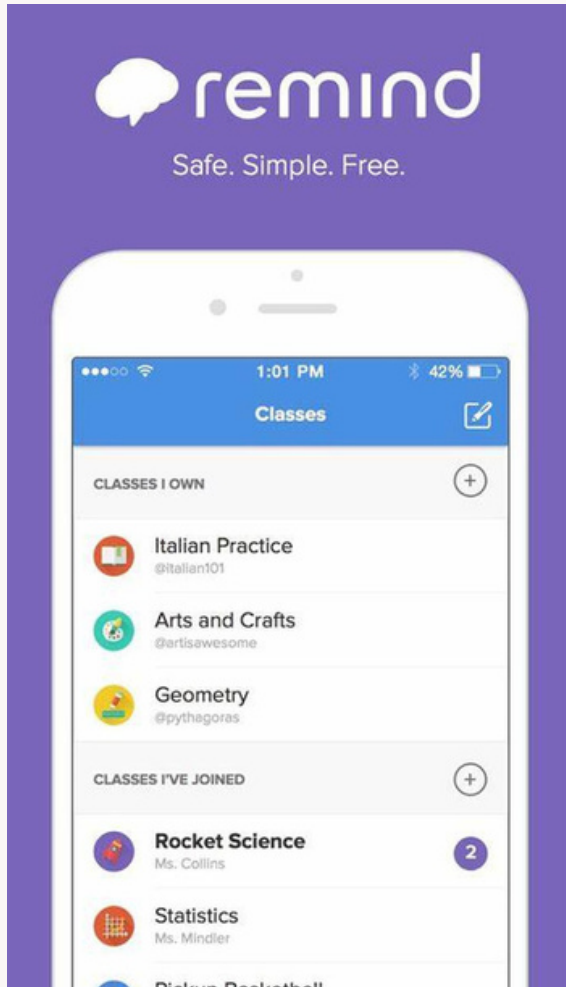
