Free Time Dress Code

Purpose of this Page This page serves as the method to collect the information about any accommodation requested at regional, state, and ILC level conferences in 2023 - 2024.

There are two reasons to fill out this form:

1. You are a competitor in one of the following four (4) events: Interviewing Skills, Personal Care, Life Support Skills, and Speaking Skills. These four (4) events in the HOSA Competitive Event Program are designed for students classified with an IEP. In order to participate in these four events, the competitor **MUST** be classified under the provision of the 2004 reauthorized Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA). Students classified under Section 504 are **NOT** eligible to compete in this event.
2. You have a special educational need or require special medical assistance and need to request an accommodation for another competitive event. Read the [GRRs](#) and [Appendix H](#) for examples of what it means to request an accommodation.

Updated Rules In Place for 2024 SLC

- Advisor responsibilities acknowledgement form
- Curfew 10:00 PM at all hotels
- No students should be left alone in the hotel without an adult chaperone
- No students or advisors are allowed to "lounge" around conference center at any time. Students must be actively involved in symposia, competing in events, visiting exhibitors, courtesy corps duties, etc., to be in the conference center. Local school chapters not staying in hotels are not allowed to camp out in the conference center.
- No students allowed to be out after dark without an adult chaperone or advisors
- All advisors should be with their students in the evening hours.
- Students should not walk alone during daylight hours – rule of thumb is to travel in groups of three
- Advisors and students should have a system in place to know where each other will be, at all times and how to make contact.
- Abide by your district/school rules for chaperoning and safety on field trips
