Event Summary

The National Geographic Learning Academic Testing Center (NGL ATC)—CareerSafe sponsored event aims to provide HOSA Members at chartered association conferences and the International Leadership Conference with additional opportunities to demonstrate their basic knowledge in preparation for becoming future health professionals.

The NGL ATC series of events consists of written tests based on items from the identified text/resource specific to each event. Competitors will recognize, identify, define, interpret, and apply knowledge in a 50-item multiple-choice test with a tie-breaker question. The written test will measure knowledge and understanding at the recall, application, and analysis levels. Higher-order thinking skills will be incorporated.

Dress Code

The Chapter Advisor will determine the dress code requirement for all SLC online testing events.

Competitors Must Provide

Laptop with internet access to the HOSA Online Testing System: https://testing.hosa.org/
Note: Competitors will receive an email with testing instructions at the address the chapter advisor entered in the HOSA system. Competitors and advisors are responsible for making sure the email address entered is not blocked by school filters.

General Rules

- 1. Competitors must be familiar with and adhere to the General Rules and Regulations.
- 2. In the event of a tie, the essay will be judged to break the tie.
- 3. The test will consist of 50 multiple-choice items in a maximum of 60 minutes.
- 4. All online tests must be taken during the SLC online testing window in a proctored setting.
