In honor of HOSA-Future Health Professionals' 50th Anniversary, the HOSA History Exam will be conducted as a special recognition event for the 2025-2026 program year. This exam offers members the opportunity to expand their knowledge of HOSA's history and its impact on the field of healthcare. The event is open to Middle School, Secondary, Postsecondary / Collegiate, Alumni, and HOSA Advisors. Pre-registration is required; there will be no walk-in testing allowed.

Dress Code

Chapter Advisor will determine the dress code requirement for all SLC online testing events.

Online Test

1. The online test will consist of 50 multiple-choice items in a maximum of 60 minutes.
2. All online tests must be taken during the SLC online testing window in a **proctored setting**.
3. One essay question will be administered with the original test.
